**PREPARATION FOR ENROLMENT AT QMC
2020/2021 – ONLINE INFORMATION**
(Information detailed below tends to relate to the
2019/20 release. It will be updated in June 2020 and
communicated to all applicants by email and online link in
readiness for enrolment.)

The application process is largely accommodated online. However, we will send you some paperwork relating to enrolment at Queen Mary's College for September 2020 by email in June 2020. Information will include:

- 1. Parent/Guardian Email** – from the Principal about the enrolment process.
- 2. Student Communication** – from the Principal about the enrolment process.
- 3. General Information Link** – With the above, you will receive a link to important information and some forms for printing, completion and return as appropriate:

- ❖ **Consent Form** – To be completed by parents/guardians to give consent for students to attend College day trips and to allow photographic/film images to be taken.

Consent for residential trips and any deemed hazardous (climbing, skiing, etc) will be sought separately for each trip.

- ❖ **Important Dates** – Dates can be found on our website as they are released www.qmc.ac.uk

- 4. Travel to College Link** - This link will contain information about QMC's Green Travel Plan and the options available for travel to College. The College arranges a number of privately chartered coaches and applications are made through College for the routes specified from June onwards. The current cost for 2019/20 is £450 (this is likely to rise for the new academic year). Applications for Stagecoach bus passes are made directly and prices will be confirmed in early summer with applications opening mid-August.

5. Course Resources Costs and Financial Support for Students Link - This link will contain information about the College Bursary and details of the additional resources costs associated with certain courses. Tuition is funded by Government, however, there is an expectation that resources costs specific to subjects should be paid at enrolment.

6. Sport at QMC & Playing for the College Teams Link – The online application system asks students to register their interest in sport and playing for College teams. Trial dates will be confirmed in the link in June 2020. We will also send general information about opportunities to get fit at QMC which will include free membership over the summer weeks.
