**PREPARATION FOR ENROLMENT AT QMC
2017/2018 – ONLINE INFORMATION**
(Information detailed below tends to relate to the 2016/17
release. It will be updated in June 2017 and posted to all
applicants in readiness for enrolment.)

The majority of the enrolment process is accommodated online. However, we will send you some **additional paperwork** relating to entry to Queen Mary's College for September 2017 **which will be posted to you in June 2017**. Information will include:

1. Parent/Guardian Letter – from the Principal about the enrolment process.

2. Student Letter – from the Principal about the enrolment process.

3. General Information Booklet – With the above letters, you will receive a booklet containing important information and some forms for completion and return as appropriate:

❖ **Consent Form** – Parents/guardians **MUST** fill this form in to give consent for students to leave the College site during the day for appointments, lunch breaks and so forth, attending non-hazardous day trips/visits, representing College at home and away sporting events, and consent for photographic/film images to be taken. Consent to residential and any trip deemed hazardous (climbing, skiing, etc) will be sought on each occasion.

❖ **Important Dates** – Dates can be found on our website as they are released www.qmc.ac.uk

4. Travel to College Booklet - This booklet will contain information about QMC's Green Travel Plan and the options available for travel to College. The College arranges a number of privately chartered coaches and applications are made through College for the routes specified from June onwards. Details of current routes are available on our website www.qmc.ac.uk. The current cost for 2016/17 is £360 (this is likely to rise for the new academic year). Applications for Stagecoach bus passes are made directly and prices will be confirmed in the Spring with applications possible by mid-August.

5. Course Resources Costs and Financial Support for Students Booklet - This booklet will contain information about the College Bursary and details of the additional resources costs associated with certain courses. Tuition is funded by Government, however, there is an expectation that resources costs specific to subjects should be paid at enrolment.

6. Sport at QMC & Playing for the College Teams Booklet – The online application system asks students to register their interest in sport and playing for College team. However, there is another opportunity to register an interest in June (trial dates will be updated in June 17). This booklet also contains general information about other opportunities to get fit at QMC.
